

Blessing of a Christmas Tree

In the home the Christmas tree may be blessed by a parent or another family member, in connection with the evening meal on the Vigil of Christmas or at another suitable time on Christmas Day.

All make the sign of the cross as the parent or leader says:

Blessed be the name of the Lord.

All: Now and forever.

One of those present or the leader reads the text of Sacred Scripture.

Brothers and sister, listen to the words of the apostle Paul to Titus (3: 4-7)

But when the kindness and generous love of God our Savior appeared not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy, He saved us through the bath of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom he richly poured out on us through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that, having been justified by his grace, we may become heirs in hope of eternal life.

Leader: Let us pray.

Lord our God,

We praise You for the light of creation:
the sun, the moon, and the stars of the night.
We praise You for the light of Israel:
The Law, the prophets, and the wisdom of the Scriptures.
We praise You for Jesus Christ, your Son:
He is Emmanuel, God-with-us, the Prince of Peace,
who fills us with the wonder of Your love.

Lord God, let your blessing come upon us as we illumine this tree. May the light and cheer it gives be a sign of the joy that fills our hearts. May all who delight in this tree come to the knowledge and joy of salvation. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

All: Amen.

Blessing of a Christmas Manger or Nativity Scene

When the manger is set up in the home, it is appropriate that it be blessed by a parent or another family member.

All make the sign of the cross as the parent or leader says:

Our help is in the name of the Lord.

All: Who made heaven and earth.

One of those present or the leader reads the text of Sacred Scripture.

Brothers and sister, listen to the words of the holy gospel according to Luke (2: 1-8)

In those days a decree went out from Caesar Augustus that all the whole world should be enrolled. This was the first enrollment when Quirinius was governor of Syria. So all went to be enrolled, each to his own town. And Joseph too went up from Galilee, from the town of Nazareth, to Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and family of David, to be enrolled with Mary, his betrothed, who was with child. While they were there, the time came for her to give birth. And she gave birth to her firstborn son. She wrapped Him in swaddling cloths and laid him in a manger, because there was no place for them in the inn.

Now there were shepherds in that region in the fields and keeping watch over their flock by night.

Leader: Let us pray.

God of every nation and people,
from the beginning of creation
You have made manifest Your love:
when our need for a Savior was great
You sent your Son to be born of the Virgin Mary,
To our lives He brings joy and peace,
justice, mercy and love.

Lord, bless all who look upon this manger, may it remind us of the humble birth of Your son Jesus, and raise up our thoughts to Him, who is God-with-us and savior of all, and who lives and reigns forever and ever.
